Reporting Daily Variances - effective immediately

The table showing the variance of the day-of-week averages from the total average circulation will now be reported once a year instead of twice a year, with the variances being calculated over the previous 12 months.

The data will be included in the December Confidential ABC Monthly Report. This means the next variance data will be available with the report for December 2023, covering the period January to December 2023.

Changes to the Standards are shown below, with shading denoting text added and strike-through text deleted.

. . .

- b) For each 126-month period (January to June and July to December) you must report a percentage variance of each day of week average UK and Republic of Ireland circulation across the 126-month period against the total average circulation for the 126-month period as follows:
 - The January to June period variances will be reported in the June ABC Report and the July to December period in the December ABC report.
 - ii) The percentage variance will be reported separately for the UK and Republic of Ireland geographical areas detailed above.
