You will be responsible for finding, resolving and reporting any bugs and/or glitches.

You must enjoy taking on new challenges and support the team to build strong technical solutions to meet the needs of our clients and the industry. You must be able to prioritise and execute tasks to deadlines.

You will work within a small collaborative team using your excellent communication skills and keen eye for detail.

Key Responsibilities

- Identify, resolve and prevent repetition of errors/bugs both in audit infrastructure and scripts;
- Document test plans, test cases, execute testing and record results. Re-write reports and repeat testing;
- Conduct appropriate technical tests pre-release of new developments;
- Support and test app development including SDK;
- Assist with some audit scripting issues;
- Work across and use a number of different platforms, tools and applications including Ruby, UNIX, SQL, Selenium, JavaScript, Appium, and PERL;
- Monitor, review and make recommendations on how current and existing audit technical developments or infrastructure can be improved having assessed and documented all potential risks;
- Work collaboratively with the ICT Team to ensure strong technical solutions or infrastructure to support the Cyber Essentials requirements whilst improving audit infrastructure efficiencies;
- To undertake ad-hoc project work, as requested and directed by Audit Managers.
